Approved by Tynwald 17th March 2009

Coming into operation 6th April 2009

The Treasury makes this Order under section 1 of the Fees and Duties Act 1989¹.

1 Title

The title of this Order is the Fees and Duties (Government Fees) Order 2009.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald² this Order comes into operation on 6th April 2009.

3 Government Fees

For each of the numbered matters set out in the Schedule there shall be charged the fee set out in the final column in respect of each matter.

4 Revocation

The Fees and Duties (Government Fees) Order 2004³ is revoked.
