Notes for Applicants - Application for renewal of a Music and Dancing Licence to a Company

Please note that a place shall not be kept or used for any entertainment purpose without a licence for that entertainment purpose granted under the Music and Dancing Act 1961 and that to do so without the appropriate licence is a criminal offence punishable by a fine not exceeding £1,000.

This application must be submitted on or before 30th November prior to the next Triennial Session of the Licensing Court
