Guidance Note - Application for grant/transfer of a Music and Dancing Licence to an Individual

Please note that a place shall not be kept or used for any entertainment purpose without a licence for that entertainment purpose granted under the Music and Dancing Act 1961 and that to do so without the appropriate licence is a criminal offence punishable by a fine not exceeding £1,000.

Music and Dancing licence applications are to be lodged with the Licensing Clerk, Summary Courts Office, Deemsters Walk, Bucks Road, Douglas, Isle of Man, IM1 3AR not less than 10 days before the hearing of the application.

Copies of applications must be served on the Chief Constable not less than 10 days before the hearing of the application.

Have you fully completed and signed your form?

Have you paid your Fee?

Have you advertised in two newspapers not less than 10 days before the hearing of the application?

Following Court, licences are produced and posted out.
