



THE CINEMATOGRAPH ACT 1977

THE CINEMATOGRAPH (LICENCE FEES) ORDER 2005

Approved by Tynwald 20th October 2005

Coming into operation 1st April 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 5(6) of the Cinematograph Act 1977(a), and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Department of Local Government and the Environment, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Cinematograph (Licence Fees) Order 2005 and, subject to section 5(6) of the Act, shall come into operation on the 1st April 2006.

Interpretation

2. In this Order, "the Act" means the Cinematograph Act 1977.

Amendment of Licence Fees

3. In section 5(5) of the Act, for "£18.50" and "£6.00" wherever occurring, substitute "£21.00" and "£6.75" respectively.

Revocation

4. The Cinematograph (Licence Fees) Order 2002 (b) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order increases, with effect from the 1st April 2006, fees in respect of the grant or renewal of a cinematograph licence from £18.50 a year to £21.00 a year. In the case of a transfer of licence, the increase is from £6.00 to £6.75.
