



CINEMATOGRAPH ACT 1977

CINEMATOGRAPH (LICENCE FEES) (No. 2) ORDER 2010

Approved by Tynwald 2011
Coming into operation 1 February 2011

The Treasury, after consultation with the Isle of Man Office of Fair Trading, makes this Order under section 5(6) of the Cinematograph Act 1977¹.

1 Title

This Order is the Cinematograph (Licence Fees) (No. 2) Order 2010.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald², this Order comes into operation on 1 February 2011.

3 Amendment of Cinematograph Act 1977

In section 5(5) of the Act, for “£21.00” and “£6.75” wherever occurring, substitute “£25.00” and “£8.00” respectively.

4 Transitional provision

Article 3 does not apply to an application made before this Order comes into operation.

5 Revocation

- (1) The Cinematograph (Licence Fees) Order 2005³ is revoked.
- (2) The Cinematograph (Licence Fees) Order 2010⁴ (insofar as it is capable of continuing to have effect) is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order increases, with effect from 1 February 2011, fees in respect of the grant or renewal of a cinematograph licence from £21.00 a year to £25.00 a year. In the case of a transfer of a licence, the increase is from £6.75 to £8.00.
