



THE FEES AND DUTIES ACT 1989

THE MUSIC AND DANCING FEES AND DUTIES ORDER 2005

Approved by Tynwald 20th October 2005

Coming into operation on 1st April 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 1 of the Fees and Duties Act 1989(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Music and Dancing Fees and Duties Order 2005 and, subject to section 1(4) of the Fees and Duties Act 1989, shall come into operation on the 1st April 2006.

(2) In this Order, "the Act" means the Music and Dancing Act 1961(b).

Application fees

2. The following fees are payable on the making of applications under the Act -

Class of application	Fee
Application for any licence under the Act (other than an occasional licence)	£19.50
Application for transfer of a licence under the Act	£19.50
Application for a variation or removal of a condition attached to a licence	£19.50

Duties payable for licences etc

3. The following duties are payable on the application form for any licence or special permission under the Act -

Licence etc.	Duty
Licence (other than an occasional licence) -	
where floor area of premises does not exceed 500 square feet	£ 31.50
where floor area of premises exceeds 500 square feet but does not exceed 10,000 square feet, for every 250 square feet or part thereof	£ 19.50
where floor area of premises exceeds 10,000 square feet	£ 742.00
Occasional licence -	
for each day or part of a day	£ 27.00
Special permission -	
for the first 2 hours or part thereof	£ 13.50
for each succeeding hour or part thereof	£ 9.00

Revocation

4. The Music and Dancing Fees and Duties Order 2002 (c) is hereby revoked.
